

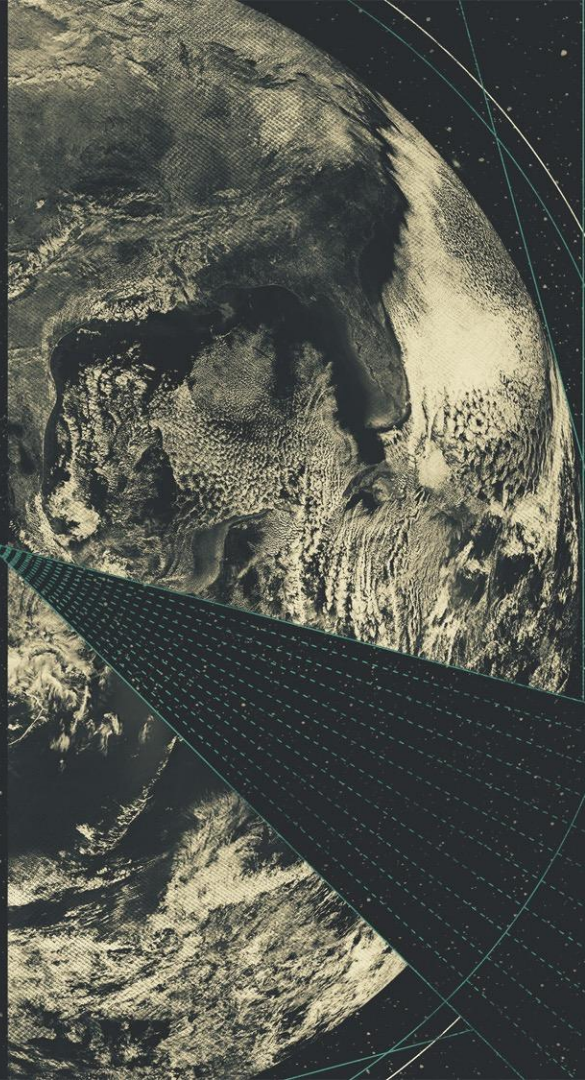


## Classical • Spiritual

# Εὐαγγέλιον • *Euangelion*

The word means "glad tidings; good or favorable news."

In the New Testament it is often translated as *Gospel*.

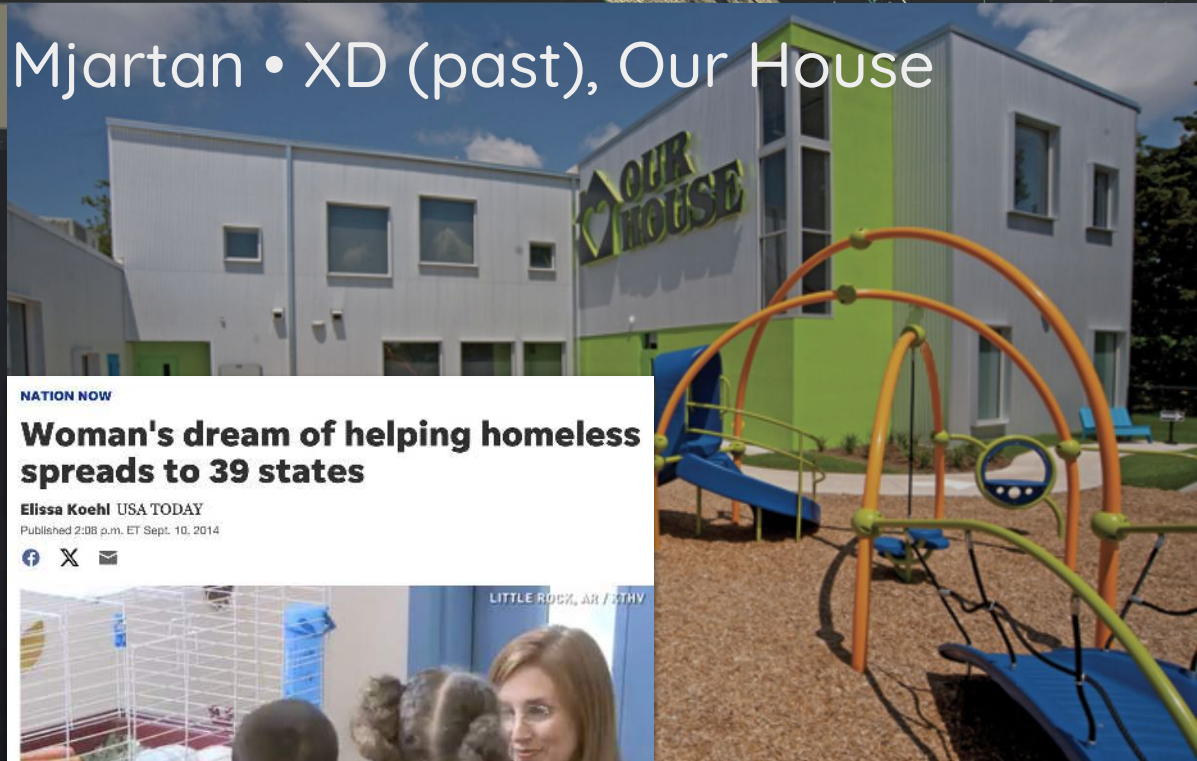

## Her Story

"On that Sunday, January 14, 2007, we arrived early and just in time for the weekly prayer meeting. Sitting with others in a small circle of prayer, I felt God's presence. Here were people of all different backgrounds, whose prayers sounded different—different intonation, different words—and all of these people were praying together to one God. Somehow, I knew that God could hear these prayers."

## Her Story

"As the room filled, I felt overwhelmed with joy. There were Black people and White people, Hispanic people, deaf people, Asians, and the blind. We were young and old, students and professionals, families with or without babies, wealthy and poor. I felt at home in this place and with these people. I felt God's presence in the music, our connectedness, and in our prayers."



# Her Story

"During the service, there was also a time of communion. Whenever I had witnessed communion as a visitor in churches prior to this, I always stayed in my seat. I knew what communion represented, and that participation meant personally accepting Christ's sacrifice. However, when communion began at Mosaic, I knew I was now ready to take part. In that moment I chose Christ, accepting Him and His sacrifice for me."

## Her Story

"After communion, there was worship and praise. I closed my eyes. I told myself that it wouldn't matter what anyone else thought of me. This was between me and my God. As I began to worship, I felt Christ's glory all around me. My hands lifted up to him. Christ had come into my heart, and he is now a part of my day-to-day life!"
